A variety of tech tools from Kerry's tool kit!

Benro Aero 4 Fluid head tripod

- Gives you super smooth pans and tilts
- Recommend a tripod that extends to 72” or so



Benro Smart Mini

- 3 devices in one: handheld shooting platform, desktop tripod, and selfie stick
- Has bluetooth remote
- About \$25



- **Square Jellyfish Tripod Mount**
- **Shoot horizontal or vertical**
- **About \$15**



Arkon tripod mount

- Attach to any tripod
- About \$50



Arkon RM179 suction cup mount

- Sticks to any smooth surface
- Heavy duty suction cup
- About \$40



Photo “L” bracket

- **Attach a smartphone mount to it, such as the Square Jellyfish**
- **Attach a video light and mini-shotgun mic if you want**
- **About \$8**



Zhiyun Smooth 4 Gimbal

- **Battery-powered 3-axis smartphone balancer**
- **Smooths out all your shots - you can even walk or run while shooting**
- **Mounts to a boom pole too**
- **Has focus/zoom knob**



Dracast 14" ring light

- Dimmable, bi-color
- Smartphone mounts in the middle of it
- Use for interviews or direct-to-camera
- About \$200



Fovitec 12" x 12" LED light

- Dimmable
- Bi-color
- Mounts to a light stand
- About \$199



Lume Cube LED light

- **10 brightness levels**
- **Built-in battery**
- **Recharges with USB cable**
- **Waterproof**
- **About \$79**



Arkon mini clip on ring light

- Use it on either side of your phone
- Dimmable
- Built-in battery
- About \$15



Lumee Duo

- **Lighted smartphone case**
- **Built-in battery**
- **Dimmable LEDs on both sides**
- **About \$69**



Aputure A.lav EZ omni-directional mic

- Kevlar-reinforced 8' cord
- Mic clip and 2 wind screens
- Carrying case
- About \$22



Tech Tools: Professional Wireless Mic



Saramonic digital wireless mic

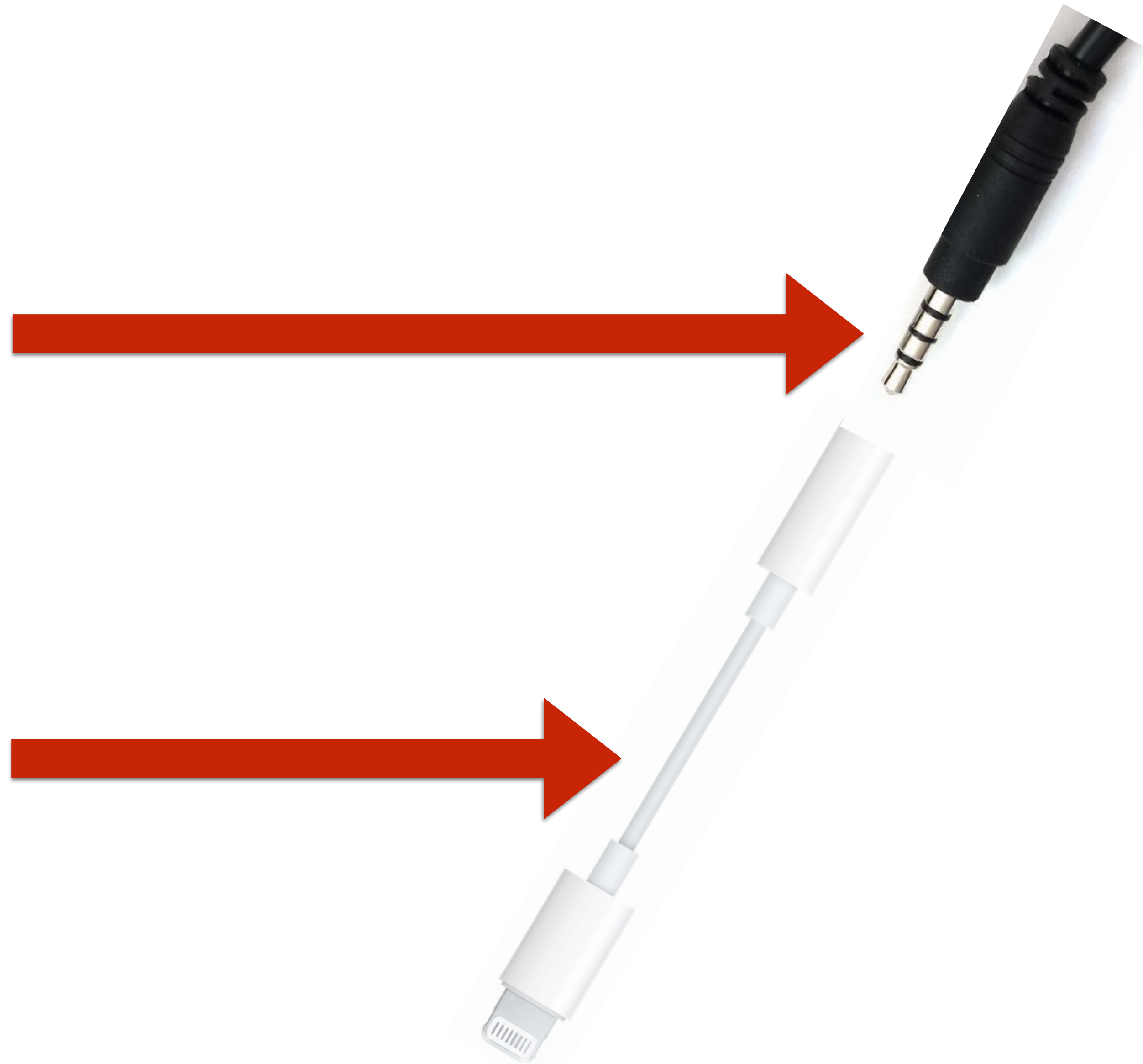
- Broadcast quality
- 9v removable batteries
- Comes with TRS-to-TRRS smartphone adapter cable
- About \$269



Tech Tools: Don't Forget To Carry This With You!



- Many smartphones have a 3.5mm “TRRS” analog audio plug
- But new iPhones don't have an analog audio plug.
- You must use Apple's Lightning adapter (one came with your phone) to convert your mic to Lightning



Tech Tools: Professional Mic Adapter/Mixer



Saramonic SmartRig+ adapter/mixer

- Connects two standard XLR mics to your smartphone
- Independent level adjustments
- Phantom power for condenser mics that require it
- Headphone jack for monitoring
- About \$99



Tech Tools: Carry One of These Too!



- **This Lightning adapter for iPhone lets you plug in a mic AND charge your phone at the same time**
- **This is really helpful for extended events or live streaming news conferences**
